

ELECTRIC-ASSIST LOAN BIKE

PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

This document is intended to help the borrower to have an enjoyable and safe experience with the loan bike. Please read it before using the bike. We hope to loan the bike to many families to demonstrate the benefits of this low carbon, low pollution method of transportation. So please look after it. We can't afford to buy another one or insure it for you.

AN EBIKE - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The bike's electric assist helps enormously on hills and moving off from stationary. We would love you to try taking any young children to school in it, leaving your car at home. Please ask your friends if they want to book a loan period.

- Before riding the bike check:
 - That the battery is charged & locked using the flat key. Otherwise it can come lose and you will lose all motor power.
 - That the battery is turned on at the rear of the bike.
 - That the red power button on the handle bar console is turned on.
 - That the front and rear bike lights are turned on. We strongly recommend using the flashing light setting during day or night time.
- If the main bike battery is empty, please charge it as soon as possible to avoid damage to it. It can be charged on the bike or unlocked and removed for charging.
- Once the main battery is fully charged it should be disconnected from the charger ASAP.
- You can check the state of charge by pressing the button on top of the battery near the switch.
- There are 3 levels of power-assist to help you pulling away and with hills.
- The power will cut out above 15mph for safety reasons but will restart if you drop below 15mph.
- The motor detects when you need power from the pressure on the bike pedals.
- We always recommend wearing a cycle helmet.
- The ebike has a stand on the left side, near the pedals which is especially useful if using the trailer.
- The ebike can be folded, after releasing the quick release lever, lift the bolt. Pedals can be folded in.





TRAILER – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Children will love travelling in the trailer, it's like a fairground ride on the way to school. It is also useful for carry supermarket shopping. Please note the following:

- The trailer can carry 1 or 2 children who should always be strapped in.
- The trailer is not suitable for children under 12 months or weighing more than 36KG (total weight of all children in the trailer).
- We strongly recommend using both trailer lights, set to 3 lights flashing during day or night-time.

The trailer can be folded flat in 2 ways.

- The Quick Fold takes less than 1 minute and folds it almost flat. Please see the other document.
- Fully Folding it flat takes about 2 or 3 minutes: taking the wheels off and folding the bike arm underneath the trailer makes it even smaller, so it can fit in the boot of a car. Please be careful of the lights as they are delicate.
