This is important as it connects Borelli Walk to the cycle route in Farnham Park and also will be close to the Abbey Street cycle track in the LCWIP document which connects through to Weydon School.

AP TL to provide more details when available of the plans by the M&S developer to spend the Section 106 money on a cycle route along Guildford Road.

## 2. REVIEW OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR

Peter Goodman presented progress made under the key themes for 2025 of Getting the Community Moving Through Sustainable Transport and Planning Applications

# Key points:

- For the 'Give It a Go' campaign FCC obtained funding from Cycling UK for leaflets, 3 banners for the town centre and Facebook advertising. Three successful Dr Bikes were held in Gostrey Meadow in partnership with Bikestart and Hoops Velo. Anecdotally this has resulted in an increase in cycling and FCC has requested evidence from local council CCTV footage or road counters. Other plans for 2026- Collaboration with Hoops Velo over Dr Bike workshops in the community. Campaign to improve the Hale Trail in Farnham Park for all users Campaign to encourage more Health Workers at the Farnham Health Centre to travel by bike.
- FCC submitted 8 responses to Planning Applications over the twelve months since the last AGM.

AP Peter S to meet with The Farnham Society planning application review team as soon as possible.

Jennet Eyre agreed that it would be good to set up a workshop with many Farnham voluntary groups to promote discussion and lobbying.

AP Jenny to chase up Jennet Eyre for the Farnham workshop.

#### 3. FINANCIAL REPORT & CONSTITUTION

The financial report was presented and approved. FCC had £571 available at the end of the reporting period and has spent all of the £386 Cycling UK grant for the Give It A Go campaign.

It was agreed to lower the number of committee members in the FCC Constitution required for a quorum from 5 to 3.
